## ISEAS – YUSOF ISHAK INSTITUTE

ISEAS – Yusof Ishak Institute (ISEAS) was the brainchild of Singapore’s first Deputy Prime Minister, Dr Goh Keng Swee. Then known as the “Institute of Southeast Asian Studies”, ISEAS was established in 1968 as an autonomous organisation by an Act of Parliament to provide a deeper understanding of a dynamic and turbulent Southeast Asia. The Institute was renamed ISEAS – Yusof Ishak Institute in August 2015 in honour of Singapore’s first President, Mr Yusof Ishak.

### **Its primary objectives are:**

- To be a leading research centre dedicated to the study of socio-political and economic trends in Southeast Asia and its wider geostrategic environment.
- To stimulate research within scholarly circles, enhance public awareness of the region, and facilitate the search for viable solutions to the varied problems confronting the region.
- To nurture a community of scholars interested in the issues of regional stability and security, economic development, and political, social and cultural change.

Today, the Institute publishes several hundred analytical commentaries and papers annually on a wide range of contemporary research topics as well as a number of academic journals and books. It holds conferences, workshops, lectures and seminars of different kinds several times a week and provides a range of research support facilities, including a large library collection.
