

Interactive Visualisation of US Exports to ASEAN

Did you know that:

- In terms of raw value of exports, the large state economies — California, Texas, Washington — send the greatest value of exports to ASEAN.
- Oregon sends more exports to ASEAN (\$3.66 billion) than New York state (\$2.11 b)
- Idaho sends a greater share of its exports to the countries of ASEAN (36%) than any other state in the United States. New Mexico (29%) and Maine are just behind (26%).

We can now access and extract more information on US exports to ASEAN, using a new interactive visualisation of US exports to ASEAN, broken down by state. Developed by the ASEAN Matters for America initiative, this new tool allows students, scholars and the interested public to view 2008 Exports data in three ways:

- Dollar value exports to ASEAN (US\$)
- Growth in exports to ASEAN, 2002-2008 (%), showing states where trade with Southeast Asia is increasing (or decreasing)
- Exports to ASEAN as share of total state exports (%), highlighting states that rely more heavily on trade with Southeast Asia
