Credited for pioneering Singapore's housing and development and enabling high home ownership in Singapore, Mr Lim Kim San went on to become a minister of crucial portfolios such as Finance, National Development, Education, Interior and Defence, Communications and Information Technology and Environment. He chaired the Council of Presidential Advisers from 1992 – 2003. He was the Chairman of several important government and corporate bodies, such as, Housing and Development Board, Public Utilities Board, Port of Singapore Authority, Singapore Press Holdings and Times Publishing, and was the Managing Director of Monetary Authority of Singapore.
