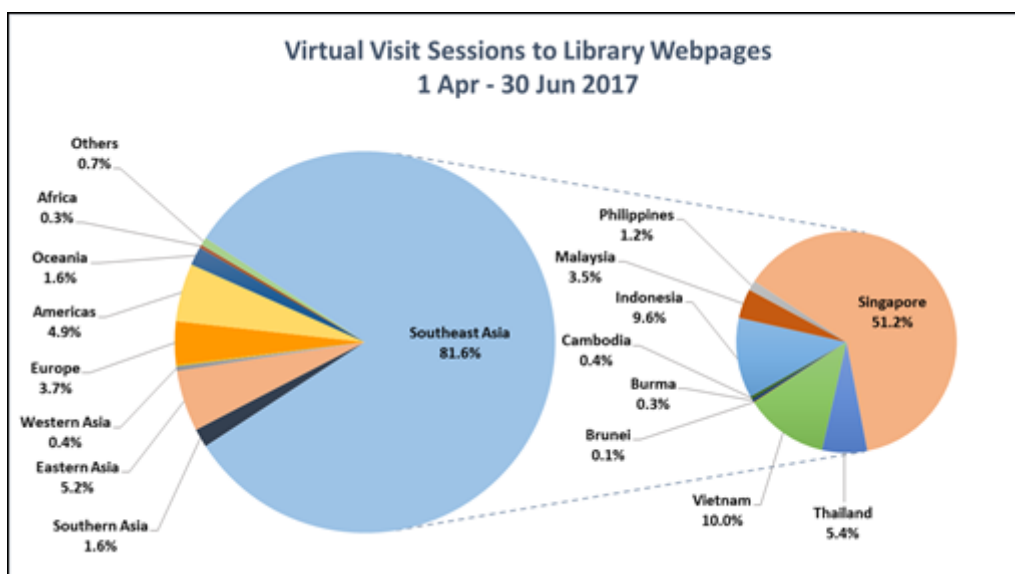
1.1 Subscription to Online News

In Jun, the Library subscribed to Jakarta Post Online which allows access to its premium articles collection, that are otherwise not available from the free online website. The contents of the online version also differs slightly from the print edition.

2 Collection Management

The Library accessioned 1,503 titles (1,231 monographs - 503 of them donated by Egawa and 274 journal articles) acquired during this period and met the KPI of releasing 95% of new titles within 14 days upon check-in.

3.2 Library Visitorship

1,410 users came through the Library in this quarter, majority of them were ISEAS researchers and followed by local university students and staff.

Among the external visitors, 59 and 76 of them viewed Yusof Ishak Gallery and NSC Archaeology Unit Gallery respectively. One of them wrote on the visitor book: "I learned more about Singapore, it's nice to know more about President Yusof Ishak."

With the deployment of a self-help desktop scanning machine at the reference counter starting this Apr, the copying usage shows a hike, i.e., 88% increase quarter-on-quarter and 5% increase year-on-year. The increase in volume is mainly attributed to scanning in addition to photocopying of books and journals.
